BILLED THROUGH THE OFFICE: ESV Bible, Lutheran Hymnary, and Small Catechism

- New students have been billed for these items and will receive them on the first day of school.
- Returning students will not be billed and should bring their copies from the previous school year.

- Two packages of #2 pre-sharpened plain pencils*
- Ticonderoga preferred
- Desk pencil sharpener w/collector for shavings (battery powered ok for desktop)
- Large eraser/eraser tops
- 12" ruler w/centimeters (one piece)
 - Not foldable
- 7" Fiskars pointed student scissors
- Large Elmer's glue stick
- Small Elmer's bottled glue
- Crayola Crayons (24 or 48-count)
 - Not washable
- Markers, broad line tip (10-count)
 - Crayola preferred
- Two black chisel tip Expo dry erase markers
- Two black fine point Sharpie permanent markers
- Two black ultra-fine point Sharpie permanent markers
- Highlighter(s)
- One set of watercolor paints (16-color)
 - Crayola or Prang preferred, w/brush
 - No fluorescent colors
- 1.5" 3-Ring Binder w/Clear View Cover

MISCELLANEOUS:

- Two wide-ruled, 100-page, spiral notebooks
- Soprano recorder, about \$7 (Amazon)
- Small personal water bottle
- Blue PLS T-shirt
- Pack of paper plates (non-Styrofoam)
